INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS IN THE 2026 ALPENFAHRT

Information for processing of personal data

(pursuant to European Regulation n° 679/2016 and Legislative Decree 196/03 and subsequent amendments)

Pursuant to current National and EU legislation on the protection of personal data, we provide the following information regarding the processing of collected personal data. The processing of personal data will be carried out in compliance with the fundamental rights and freedoms of the interested party in accordance with the principle of fairness, lawfulness and transparency.

Purpose and Legal Basis of Processing

The Company will process personal data exclusively for activities related to its participation in Alpenfahrt 2026. The processing of personal data is based on the explicit consent of the interested party (or of the person exercising parental responsibility if the interested party is a minor).

Nature of the provision of data

Providing your data is necessary for the aforementioned purpose and to execute the agreement with the data controller. Providing your data is not mandatory, but refusal to provide certain data may result in your ineligibility for the competition.

Recipients/Categories of Recipients

For the purposes of participation at the event, your data may be subject to communication in order to comply with the obligations by the related to the organization and implementation of the race itself, to comply with the Sporting and Technical Regulations dictated by the competent authorities or to fulfill contractual obligations assumed by the company for the implementation of the race itself.

Depending on the case, by way of example and not exhaustively, your data may be communicated:

- to racetracks, officials, organizers, and any other person involved in any capacity in the organization and competition promotion;
- To the Automobile Club d'Italia (ACI);
- To Federation Internationale de l'Automobile (FIA) and/or specific Commission of the FIA (CIK, etc.), other bodies or related bodies;
- the ACI department for Automobile Sport;
- other companies of the Group of which ACI Sport S.p.a. is part.

The person concerned is aware that by participating in this competition, some of your data, such as your image and name, or the pseudonym you have chosen for participation in the competition, will be disseminated. Videos and photographs provided by you, or shots made in every and any public event related to the competition, may be used, broadcast of disseminated by any type, way, means and system of communication and dissemination, also for advertising and commercial purposes.

Data transfer abroad

The data collected may be transferred to a third country, including outside European Union, if strictly necessary for the organization and promotion of the race and in accordance with the rules established by the FIA.

Automated decision-making processes

The Data Controller does not use any automated decision-making processes regarding the personal data of the interested party.

Data retention period

The data will be retained for the time necessary to achieve the purposes for which it was collected and to manage the contractual obligations and regulatory requirements on which the processing is based, as well as to fulfill accounting and tax purposes as required by law.



Right of the interested party

At any time, the interested party may contact the Data Controller at the address above to exercise their rights, listed below, in accordance with EU Regulation 679/2016 and the National legislation in force:

- Right of access: The interested party has the right to obtain confirmations to whether or not personal data concerning him or her is being processed, and, where that in case, to obtain access to the personal data. He or she may request this at any time the purposes of the processing, the categories of data processed, the recipients to whom the personal data has been or will be disclosed, the data retention period, the existence of rights in his or her favor, the source of the data, whether automated processing is used.
- Right of rectification: The interested party has the right to obtain from the data controller without undue delay the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning him or her. Furthermore, the data subject has the right to have incomplete personal data completed, including by providing a supplementary statement. In this case, the data controller will be required to inform each recipient to whom the personal data has been disclosed of any such rectification.
- Right to erasure: The data subject has the right to obtain the erasure of personal data concerning him or her without undue delay and to request its deletion. Furthermore, if his or her data has been made public, the data controller will erase it and take reasonable measures, including technical measures, to inform data controllers processing the personal data of the data subject's request to erase any copies of his or her personal data.
- Right to restriction of processing: If the data subject deems it appropriate, they may request the restriction of processing of their personal data and limit such processing in the future. In this case, the data controller will communicate any restrictions on processing to each recipient to whom the personal data have been disclosed, unless this proves impossible or involves a disproportionate effort.
- Right to data portability: The data subject has the right to receive personal data concerning him or her in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format and to request that it be retained for further use for personal purposes. Furthermore, the data subject has the right to request the direct transmission of his or her data to another controller without hindrance, where technically feasible.
- Right to object to processing: The data subject has the right to object at any time, for reasons relating to his or her particular situation, to the processing of personal data concerning him or her.
- Right to withdraw consent: In the case of consent-based processing, the data subject may withdraw the consent given for processing. However, this does not affect the validity of the processing carried out by the data controller up to that point.
- Right to lodge a complaint with the Garante della Privacy: If the data subject believes that his or her data has been processed unlawfully and violates the rules and principles regarding personal data protection, he or she has the right to lodge a complaint with the Garante della Privacy (Italian Data Protection Authority), according to the procedures established by the latter.
